This year the workshop visited Hungary under the guardianship of Bela Buky. Selected papers from the Workshop were published in *Biology of the Neonate* [7]. The topics covered at the Workshop included anti-surfactant antibodies, computer-aided image analysis of surfactant bubbles, factors affecting outcome in surfactant treated infants, the effect of diet on surfactant phospholipid composition, lung mechanics after surfactant administration, costs of surfactant treatment and long term outcome with regard to pulmonary function and retinopathy of prematurity. Contributors were from the USA, Sweden, Spain, Germany, Netherlands, Italy, Belgium, France and UK. This was the first meeting at which papers were published in *Biology of the Neonate* and we are grateful to Jean Pierre Relier, then the Editor-in-Chief for facilitating this arrangement.

The social programme included visits to the healing and warm spa waters, the casino (for some) and an impromptu cabaret show enjoyed particularly by Garth McClure, Angela Bell and Lotte Skov. At the Gala Dinner delegates were entertained by a gypsy fiddler whose baby had been the first Curosurf-treated baby in Hungary.
