

## 11. Tübingen 1996

For this Workshop, Christian Speer was again the President. Although sponsored both by Chiesi Farmaceutici and Ares Serono this was a small workshop restricted to 60 delegates from 20 countries. The meeting was held at the historical Castle of Hohentübingen.

The abstracts of the meeting were published in *Biology of the Neonate* [11]. Nineteen papers were presented with just over half the papers relating to basic science and the rest to various clinical aspects of surfactant treatment. At this meeting there was lots of discussion and agreement about future research perspectives.

The welcome dinner was at the very impressive Hohenzollern Castle and was hosted by his Royal Highness Prince Michael of Prussia. This was a very special occasion and included a guided tour of the Castle. At the farewell dinner there were the traditional musical contributions, directed by Sol-Britt Curstedt on the piano with dancing well beyond midnight.
